

10 Distilleries To Visit In North Carolina And Tennessee

1. South Mountain Distilling - Connelly Springs NC

Have you ever heard of the Legendary Moonshiner Popcorn Sutton? Well Moonshiner J.B. Rader, who helped Popcorn on one of his last moonshine runs, now has his shine for sale through this great distillery; along with some other greats such as Moonshiner Kelly Williamson from Moonshiners on Discovery TV!

If you find yourself in central North Carolina, this is a great spot to visit, tour the distillery, have a tasting, and see their many moonshine and whiskey products. And if Moonshiner Don is there, make sure you get a photo with him!

2. Broad Branch Distillery – Winston-Salem NC

Broad Branch Distillery is a wonderful spot in Winston-Salem North Carolina that features many craft spirits that you will love experiencing. Master Distiller Don was actually on an episode of Moonshiners, the Whiskey Business series, that they did years ago.

There is also a brewery and food in the shopping complex where Broad Branch Distillery is located, so you can plan on making a night out of it. And the Winston-Salem area is full of great restaurants and things to do, so put this area on your route!

3. Outer Banks Distilling – Manteo NC

5. M and T Distilling – Hendersonville NC

6. Southern Distilling Co. Statesville NC

7. Blue Note Bourbon Distilling Memphis TN
